



WELCOME TO THE KIDS IN THE MARSH SUMMER DAY CAMP

Whether your child is in the full day or half-day program, he or she will enjoy a week of outdoor nature exploration through hikes, environmental activities, mini environmental lessons, crafts and games all linked to a theme of the week. **To ensure your child has an enjoyable time at camp, please read this letter carefully for important details.**

WHAT TO BRING/TO DO FOR CAMP

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE KIM CAMP IS PEANUT/NUT FREE. (Products such as NUTELLA, labels with 'may contain nuts/peanuts' or 'processed at a facility with nuts/peanuts' are not permitted at camp.)

- Water and water bottle
- Lunch (full day participants only)
- Snacks (2 for full day campers)
- Hat
- Sunscreen
- Bug Spray
- Sweater
- Proper Lunch Bag (**PLEASE NO PLASTIC BAGS!**)
- Comfortable & weather appropriate clothing and footwear (shorts & running shoes)*
* No sandals please as your child(ren) will be participating in hikes and games
- Please have sunscreen and bugspray applied before arriving at camp

LOCATION AND DIRECTIONS TO DAY CAMP

The program is situated at Darlington Provincial Park in Courtice in **PICNIC SHELTER #3**. Please take the Courtice Road exit from Highway 401 and follow the signs to the park. The Park is located south of Highway 401. If you require specific directions, please call the park at (905) 436-2036 extension 221.

Please drop off and pick up your child(ren) at picnic Area #3 only. Please fill out the 'Sign in Form' indicating who will be dropping off and picking up your child(ren). Please note that parents/guardians will need to sign their child(ren) out before they can leave the camp. If you are picking up your child(ren) early please inform staff at the beginning of the day.

PROGRAM HOURS & EARLY/LATE SUPERVISION

Half day program: 9 am to 12 pm, or 1 pm to 4 pm

Full day program: 9 am to 4 pm, with supervised lunch from 12 noon to 1 pm

Early/Late supervision fee is paid directly to Friends of Second Marsh at the camp.

Early supervision hours: 8:30 am to 9 am

Late supervision hours: 4 pm to 4:30 pm

Cost: \$10 per week for early supervision and \$10 per week for late supervision. Only cash or cheques will be accepted as payment.

ENTRY PASS- REQUIRED!

Entry passes will be provided to you on Monday at sign in. These passes are required and are only valid for dropping off/picking up your children from the park. Please place the entry pass on your dashboard **so it is visible to the park attendant on the left side of the dashboard.** Please obey all traffic/road signs in the park, including **coming to a complete stop at the gate and speed limit signs (40km/hr).**

Please note that the day camp cost does not include admission to the park. If you would like to use the park, please obtain an admission ticket from the registration office.

Other Information

The **program will run on rainy/hot days** but the activities will be modified to suit the weather.

Lunches should be sent in proper lunch containers and backpacks, not plastic bags. **In the past squirrels and other animals have gotten into the plastic bag lunches.** We encourage campers to pack their lunch in a mini hardtop cooler if possible and to avoid thin fabric lunch bags.

Please note that Friends of Second Marsh staff will be taking pictures of the camp activities and participants throughout the summer for publicity purposes. A photography release form will be given to parents/guardians to fill out.

On Thursdays a survey will be distributed to the children to take home. Please fill it out, and bring it back on Friday. Your feedback is very important to us!

Please call the office and let us know if your child(ren) will be absent from camp. Thank you!
