

Kids in the Marsh Summer Day Camp
Sun Screen and Bug Repellant Policy & Procedures

Sun Screen Policy:

To limit sun exposure, activities at the camp alternate between the sun and shade locations. It is highly recommend that children bring and wear hats to protect their heads and face from the sun. Water breaks are taken throughout the day to ensure kids are well hydrated.

Children are required to apply sunscreen every 1.5-2 hours throughout the day. Sunscreen will be applied more frequently when children are engaged in water games and active play. Kids in the Marsh (KIM) staff can assist with applying spray on sunscreen only. With regards to non-spray sunscreen (i.e. lotion form), KIM staff can squirt the lotion on the child's hands but the child will be required to rub in the lotion into their skin under the direction of the KIM staff.

Bug Repellent Policy:

Throughout the day, children participate in hikes at Darlington Provincial Parks. It is recommended that children apply bug repellent prior to the hike to protect and prevent bites from mosquitoes, black flies and other biting insects.

Kids in the Marsh (KIM) staff can assist with applying spray on bug repellent only. With regards to non-spray bug repellent (i.e. lotion form), KIM staff can squirt the lotion on the child's hands but the child will be required to rub in the lotion into their skin under the direction of the KIM staff.

- We have child-friendly spray on sunscreen and bug repellent available at the camp. Should my child forgot to bring their sunscreen and bug repellent from home, I give KIM staff permission to provide my child with the camp supply of sunscreen and/or bug spray and apply the spray on sunscreen/bug repellent as needed.
